Section III. Bid Data Sheet

ITB Clause	
5.3	<p>For this purpose, contracts similar to the Project shall be:</p> <p>a. The name of the Contract is <i>Supply and Delivery of Canned Sardines</i>, similar contracts shall refer to <i>Supply and Delivery of Canned Goods</i>.</p> <p>b. completed within three (3) years prior to the deadline for the submission and receipt of bids.</p>
7.1	<p><i>Subcontracting is not allowed.</i></p>
12	<p>The price of the Goods shall be quoted DDP (state place of destination) or the applicable International Commercial Terms (INCOTERMS) for this Project.</p>
14.1	<p>The bid security shall be in the form of a Bid Securing Declaration, or any of the following forms and amounts:</p> <p>a. The amount of not less than Php 84,000.00 (<i>indicate the amount equivalent to two percent (2%) of ABC</i>), if bid security is in cash, cashier's/manager's check, bank draft / guarantee or irrevocable letter of credit; or</p> <p>b. The amount of not less than Php 210,000.00 (<i>Indicate the amount equivalent of five percent (5%) of ABC</i>) if bid security is in Surety Bond.</p>
15	<p><i>Each Bidder shall submit one (1) original and one (1) copy of the first and second components of its bid. Copy 1 should be a replica of the original as to appearance and contents.</i></p>
19.2	<p><i>Detailed Evaluation and Comparison of Bids</i></p> <p>Partial bid is not allowed. The goods are grouped in a single lot and the lot shall not be divided into sub-lots for the purpose of bidding, evaluation, and contract award.</p> <p>In all cases, the NFCC computation, if applicable, must be sufficient for all the lots or contracts to be awarded to the Bidder.</p>

19.3	<p><i>[In case the project will be awarded by lot, list the grouping of lots by specifying the group title, items, and the quantity for every identified lot, and the corresponding ABC for each lot.]</i></p> <p><i>[In case the project will be awarded by the item, list each item indicating its quantity and ABC.]</i></p>
20.1	<p><i>Post-Qualification</i></p> <p>Within a non-extendible period of five (5) calendar days from receipt by the Bidder of the notice from the BAC that it submitted the Lowest Calculated Bid, the Bidder shall submit its latest income and business tax returns filed and paid through the BIR Electronic Filing and Payment (eFPS) and other appropriate licenses and permits required by law and stated in the BDS.</p>
21.2	<p>Supplier must have an existing Landbank of the Philippines (LBP) Account in compliance to DBM Circular Letter No. 2013-16. This shall be verified during the conduct of post-qualification.</p>
