



INVITATION TO BID

NEGOTIATED PROCUREMENT AFTER TWO-FAILED BIDDINGS for the “Supply, Delivery, and Installation of Video Wall System and Audio/Video Conferencing System for DSWD Field Office VII Operations Center”

Project Identification No.: ITB No. DSWD7-NP-2021-04

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1. The *Department of Social Welfare and Development, Field Office VII (DSWD-FO VII)*, through the *authorized appropriations for Fiscal Year 2021 General Appropriations Act* intends to apply the sum of **Three Million Pesos Only (₱3,000,000.00)** payments under the contract for the **NEGOTIATED PROCUREMENT AFTER TWO-FAILED BIDDINGS for the “Supply, Delivery, and Installation of Video Wall System and Audio/Video Conferencing System for DSWD Field Office VII Operations Center”**. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.
 2. The *DSWD Field Office VII* now invites bids from **PhilGEPS registered service providers**. Delivery of the services is required within **Section VI. Schedule of Requirements**. Bidders should have completed, within *seven (7) years* from the date of submission and receipt of bids, a **single largest completed contract (SLCC)** similar to the Project, of **at least 50% of the ABC or amounting to at least ₱1,500,000.00, it can also an aggregate of two or more similar completed contracts, provided that there is one contract equivalent to at least half of the 25% of the ABC or amounting to Php 750,000.00**.

Similar contracts shall refer to **Supply and Delivery of Office Video Wall System and Audio/Video Conferencing System or Supply and Delivery of ICT Equipment**.

The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II. Instructions to Bidders.

3. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using a non-discretionary “pass/fail” criterion as specified in the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) 9184, otherwise known as the “Government Procurement Reform Act”.

Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines, and to citizens or organizations of a country the laws or regulations of which grant similar rights or privileges to Filipino citizens, pursuant to RA 5183.

(h) Conformity with the Schedule of Requirements and Technical Specifications, which may include production / delivery schedule, manpower, requirement, and/or after-sales/parts, if applicable; **and**

(i) Original duly signed Omnibus Sworn Statement (OSS); **and** if applicable, Original Notarized Secretary's Certificate in case of a corporation, partnership, or cooperative, or Original Special Power of Attorney of all members of the joint venture giving full power and authority to its officer to sign the OSS and do acts to represent the Bidder.

(l) Service provider must have an existing Landbank of the Philippines (LBP) Account in compliance **with DBM Circular Letter No. 2013-16**. Participating bidder must attach a photocopy of their bank account details (bank account name, number and branch) in the bids submitted. This shall be verified during the conduct of post-qualification.
